FRESH ACCESS BUCKS PROGRAM REGIONAL COORDINATOR

Florida Organic Growers (FOG) carries out its mission statement by providing the community with programs and resources that promote and support sustainable and fair agriculture as well as healthy living. These programs include farmers market EBT, on-farm workshops, social justice and food and agriculture policy. Fresh Access Bucks makes fresh, local produce more affordable and accessible to low income families while supporting Florida's farmers and enhancing our local economies. Fresh Access Bucks increases the purchasing power of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) participants by providing a one-to-one match for Florida grown fruits and vegetables. A SNAP cardholder who spends \$10 of their benefits at a participating market receives an additional \$10 to purchase fresh, local produce.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

FOG is seeking a **Fresh Access Bucks Program Northwest or South Regional Coordinator** to join our expanding team. The position is part time at 25 hours per week, with a semi-flexible schedule. With consistent growth over the past 7 years, FOG is looking for a candidate to work both independently and as part of an efficient leadership team. As part of the Fresh Access Bucks team, this position will be directly responsible for the day to day tasks of the project in the Northwest or South region of the state, overall coordination of market selection, partnerships with other organizations, trainings, statewide convening, implementation of EBT Technology, monitoring project progress and more. This is an exciting opportunity to support low income families and Florida farmers in a fast paced environment.

DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Work directly with the Fresh Access Bucks Co-Managers to assist in coordination of the Fresh Access Bucks Program;
- Provide technical assistance for partner markets including support for community building, building partner capacity, monitoring program, providing tools and resources;
- Identify and vet new partner markets;
- Conduct site visits to partner markets;
- Assist organizing statewide partner convening and facilitating monthly calls with partner markets;
- Promote the FAB program and farmers markets in general;
- Plan, develop, and evaluate outreach and education activities;
- Perform other duties as requested.
